Dear Mr. Tharp:

Since I have become cognisant of the dangers of using and dispensing carcinogenic insecticides I have changed my methods of controlling ticks and fleas. I now use Perma-Guard products exclusively to control these pests in my small animal hospital. For this reason I dispense Perma-Guard to my clients to control these external pests.


I also have found in feeding the trace mineral Fossil Shell Flour to dogs that some internal parasites can be controlled.

In clinical observation of cases in my hospital I have found by feeding fossil flour at the rate of approximately 1 tablespoon full for dogs over 35 lb. and 1 teaspoon full for small dogs that over a period of one week or more that all the ova disappear from the stools on microscopic examinations. I have had good results in controlling Ascarids (*Toxocara Canis*), hook worms (*Ancylostoma Caninum*), and whip worms (*Trichuris Vulpis*).

I have experienced some slow cases in hooks in which I fed small amounts of Basic Perma-Guard to obtain desired elimination of these difficult worms.

I am continuing my investigation and will keep you posted of any new findings.
